## UNL Coach Revelle to fly with U.S. Air Force Thunderbirds

**OFFUTT AFB, Neb.** –University of Nebraska Softball Coach Rhonda Revelle will don a flight suit and climb aboard a U.S. Air Force Thunderbird F-16 fighter aircraft Aug. 15, as part of Air Force Week in the Heartland celebrations,

Coach Revelle has been invited to take an orientation flight with the Air Force’s premier aerial demonstration team.

Entering her 17th season as Nebraska's head coach in 2009, Coach Revelle has directed the Huskers to one of the most successful stretches in program history. Last season, Coach Revelle became the 48th coach in the history of NCAA Division I softball to post 600 career victories.

The winningest UNL coach in program history, Coach Revelle became the first female coach of any sport in Nebraska history to record both 500 career victories and 500 victories at Nebraska. An 8-0 win over Cal State Fullerton on March 19, 2005, gave her career win No. 500, and a 3-2 win over Texas Tech on April 17 made Coach Revelle only the third coach in Nebraska history to lead any Big Red team to 500 victories.
